



### **2006-2007 IRTHA Tryout Policy**

#### **Tryout Policy:**

If a player tries out for a specific team (this does not include pre-skates) and that player is selected for that team, that is the ONLY team that player is eligible to play for.

Getting picked for a team and then deciding that the player wants to play for a different team causes hardship on the next player who would have been picked and is told they are cut. The chain reaction then affects the teams below.

#### **Tryout pre-approved absence policy:**

All players wishing to be considered for a given team must be on the ice for that team's tryout sessions. In an extreme situation where a player cannot attend a team's tryout sessions, an email must be submitted to IRTHA's Executive Director prior to the first tryout session by the parents and the head coach asking for a pre-approved absence. The Executive Director will email all parties back with a decision prior to the first tryout. This procedure in no way guarantees selection for the team, however, team membership will not be considered if it is not followed. A player who does not attend tryouts or receive approval to miss tryouts for a given team, will not be rostered by that team at any time during the season without prior approval of the IRTHA Board of Directors.
