

Kevin Mallin

Born and raised in Shaker Heights, Ohio, Kevin began playing hockey at the age of 3 at the local skating rink. Kevin had a successful High School career guiding his team to a State Title while going undefeated in 1980-81. After graduating with honors from Shaker Heights High School in 1982, Kevin attended Miami University in Oxford, Ohio. Kevin was a walk-on at the D-I University and began playing on the Miami Club team. After a month, Kevin was called up to the Varsity squad periodically. Kevin continued to play on the Miami Club team until his senior year when shoulder surgery ended his career as a player.

During Kevin's years at Miami, he began refereeing youth, High School, and College Club hockey games. After progressing quickly up the officiating ranks, he began officiating D-I hockey and professional hockey in 1987. Kevin then was offered a position with the National Hockey League as a Referee Trainee and served in this capacity for one year. Although Kevin's career in the NHL was short-lived, he continued to officiate at all levels of the minor leagues totaling 21 years to date. Kevin officiated in a Canada Cup Exhibition Series game in Pittsburgh, 4 regular season NHL games, IHL's Turner Cup Finals, AHL's Calder Cup Playoffs, ECHL's Kelly Cup Playoffs, UHL's Playoffs, IHL's All-Star Game, CHL, OHL, CCHA, US Junior A Championships, NAHL All-Star Game, and an untold number of youth hockey games.

Kevin has also been active in the Lakeland Junior Evaluation Hockey Camps where he served as the Regional Director and Developmental Coach for over ten years. Kevin's responsibilities were managing all aspects of logistics and marketing, recruiting players and coaches to attend the Indianapolis, Indiana camps as well as determine candidates for the Super Camp of Excellence in Grand Forks, North Dakota.

Kevin currently referees in the CHL where his focus is mentoring young officials into the professional ranks. Kevin manages a local men's tournament team that competed in the US Elite non-check Championships in Lansing, Michigan in 2007. Kevin served the IRTHA Board during the summer of 2007 in the capacity of hiring the 2007-08 coaching staff.

Kevin is a Certified and Licensed Professional Geologist working for a local environmental consulting firm. Kevin is also an active board member in the Indiana Society of Hazardous Materials Managers. Kevin also serves as an age group manager for the very successful Carmel United Soccer Club where two of his daughters compete.
